The Eyewitness	Explore the Great Fire of London through diary accounts and first-hand stories, building the event through drama and role-play.	Supports: History, literacy, speaking & listening

Key Stage Two

The Myth Maker	Explore Ancient Greek myths through performance and storytelling.	Supports: History, literacy, imagination
The Skald	Discover Norse myths and storytelling traditions through spoken word and drama.	Supports: History, oracy, cultural understanding
The Playwright	Explore Shakespeare's world through language and performance.	Supports: History, English, drama
The Novelist	Use Dickens to explore Victorian Britain and social change.	Supports: History, literacy, critical thinking

Pupils explore big questions about relationships, fairness, identity and the world we live in, using drama to examine different perspectives and develop their own voice.
