Skills Workshops

Devising Drama	How do you turn an idea into a performance?	Create an original piece, exploring how ideas are shaped, structured and brought to life.	Supports: GCSE Drama (devising), creativity, collaboration
Physical Performance	What can you say without speaking?	Use movement and physicality to communicate character, relationships and meaning.	Supports: Physical theatre, non-naturalistic performance
Powerful Projection	How can you use your voice effectively?	Develop vocal control, projection and clarity for performance and presentation.	Supports: Oracy, GCSE performance, communication
Ensemble Energy	What makes a strong ensemble?	Build group performance skills, including timing, awareness and responsiveness.	Supports: Collaboration, rehearsal skills, ensemble work
